### 2021-2022 Payment Agreement Form

The band fee for a South-Doyle High School Band student, regardless of class, will be \$150. This fee reflects a \$50 decrease to help accommodate families facing financial hardship due to COVID-19. The directors want parents to know that we are continuing to make a great effort to be as frugal as possible and keep costs as low as possible. The band camp fee is \$100 and is required from everyone participating in the marching band. This cost is not covered under the free and reduced lunch option. Included in this cost is the student's band shirt.

If your student plays a school-owned instrument (percussion, sousaphone, baritone, mellophone, bass clarinet, tenor sax, bari sax, etc.) there is an additional \$50 maintenance cost. This is to help offset the expense of maintaining our instrument inventory. If a student negligently damages an instrument, this fee does not cover any repair costs.

**The most it would cost your child to be in band for one year is \$300.00! There is also a \$50 discount on the band fee if you have two or more students in band living at the same residence.**

**What do the fees pay for?** Band camp expenses, instructional staff, transportation, new uniforms, uniform cleaning, uniform maintenance, music, drill design, field maintenance, guard equipment, half-time drinks, adjudicators, festival/competition fees, and first aid. Basically, fees cover anything we need to operate this band program all year long.

**Fundraising:** As a 501(c) 3 organization, we are allowed two tax-free fundraisers. These fundraisers will be announced shortly after school starts. It is important that each student participate in the fundraising. Fee money covers a small portion of the total expense that is required to operate our band. The booster organization will determine a quota for each student to sell. Monies raised beyond that quota will go toward students' accounts to help offset fees or additional travel.

**Drum Major/Guard/Majorette Uniform Purchase:** Drum Major, Color Guard, and Majorettes are responsible for the purchase of the designated uniform for the year. (This is in addition to the fees for the semester). All uniforms must be approved by Mr. Mull before they are ordered. **Payment must be received before the uniform will be issued to the student.** The uniform will become the property of the student at the conclusion of the season.

**UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE do we want finances to keep a student from being a member of the South-Doyle High School Band. Please contact Mr. Mull as soon as possible to discuss any financial concerns.**
